### SSSS ANNUAL MEETING:

## Membership Categories

**Student Memberships** are available at a reduced rate to those currently enrolled in a relevant course of study.

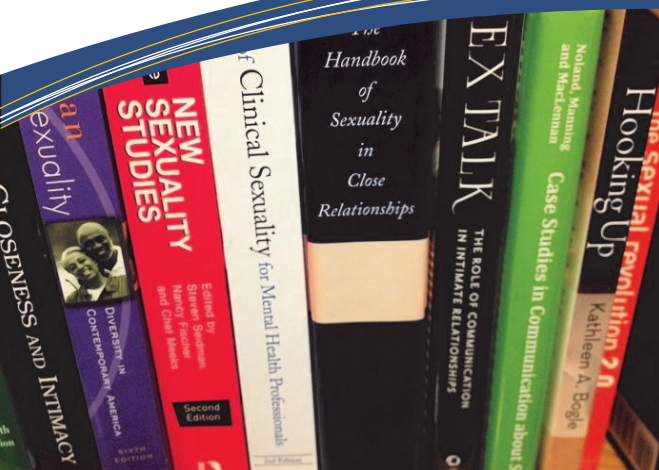
